- Gender, equality policies and sexual diversity

ECONOMIC CONDITIONS

This project is founded by the European Commission and it covers:

- **Travel costs** (up to the limits established by the <u>Erasmus+</u> <u>Distance Calculator</u>)
- Support for accommodation, maintenance and pocket money

La Xixa will transfer to your bank account the established monthly amount.

Before your departure **you will be responsible to find your own accommodation in Barcelona**. La Xixa will provide you with all the support and the information you will need.

SUPPORT

Before your departure, La Xixa will assign you a tutor, who will help you from the moment you decide to join us until you go back home, in everything concerning the activities you will carry out with us and other issues that might worry you.



BARCELONA

Barcelona is a city on the coast of northeastern Spain. It is the capital and largest city of the autonomous community of Catalonia, as well as the second most populous municipality of Spain with a population of 1.6 million people.

Barcelona is home to many people coming from different parts of Spain, Europe and the world. It is characterised by a high number of organisations working in the social sector and by a lively social life and debate, in which however many voices are still unheard.

La Xixa is part of the social and activist network, working everyday and step-by-step to foster intercultural dialogue and active participation of all people living in our beautiful city, in order to promote a real social transformation and contribute to the construction of a more inclusive and just society.

DID YOU KNOW THAT SPANISH IS NOT THE ONLY LANGUAGE WE SPEAK?



Barcelona's soul is rooted in its history, traditions and language. Barcelona is a bilingual city in which **Catalan** and **Spanish** are both spoken by its population.

During your stay in Barcelona you will have the opportunity to be in contact with both languages.

The Online Language Support (OLS) is a tool provided by the European Commission in order to help you with your Spanish. Furthermore, if you are interested in learning Catalan, there are courses that you can access for free through the Consorci per a la normalització lingüística



- Your ID card and/or Passport (if you have it, bring it!)
- European Health Insurance Card and CIGNA insurance card (if you are not resident in Spain) or Spanish Health Card (if you are resident in Spain)
- Criminal record certificate
- Reservation and original copies of your travel tickets/boarding passes (they are needed for reimbursement).
- Your laptop.
- The rest (clothes, shoes, personal items) is up to you. The weather is overall warm, but be careful we do have winter!
- We recommend you to buy a Spanish **SIM Card** (if you don't have it) as soon as you arrive.
